- 1.1 Seat gate hinges on both gudgeons, and adjust to ensure: gate conforms to contour; ground clearance is uniform when gate is shut; and gudgeons are adjusted tightly into end assembly.
- 1.2 Adjust to ensure gate swings in given direction to given point maintaining ground clearance and closing parallel onto slam.
- 1.3 Fix latch for ease of opening with minimal chain slackness.
