- 1.1 Use electric fence tester to identify location of fault, and report findings.
- 1.2 Identify faults in electric fence components and replace components.  
  
 Range components may include but are not limited to – cut-off switch, undergate cable, end insulator, post insulator, electric fence support post, line clamp, outrigger; evidence of three components is required.
- 1.3 Identify causes of a short out in electric fences.

Range causes include but are not limited to – debris, vegetation, branches, loose fence components; evidence of two causes is required.
