Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to operate a hand held post hole borer.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Check post hole borer for suitability for the job and maintain prior to use in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

Range throttle cable and its operation, linkages, kill switch, auger pins.
- 1.2 Select auger size to match post size and depth.
- 1.3 Check site for obstructions, and remove obstructions, or adjust work plan accordingly.

Outcome 2

Operate a hand held post hole borer.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Anchor post hole borer and start in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.2 Operate post hole borer in correct position, ensuring work is carried out in a manner which does not cause risk of injury to operator or other people.
- 2.3 Maintain full control of post hole borer at all times.
- 2.4 Bore hole to match post size and required depth, in line with guide wires.
- 2.5 Retract borer at idle and switch off in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.6 Transport post hole borer without risk of damage to equipment and risk of injury to self or other people.
- 2.7 Maintain post hole borer following use in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
