- 2 Tasks to be performed as evidence for this unit standard include:
 - empty and replace vacuum cleaner bags;
 - apply mould treatment;
 - wash the exterior of a house;
 - clean a stove.
- 3 Assessment for this unit standard can be holistic where the knowledge and skills are assessed in conjunction with the outcomes in other unit standards from the *Building, Construction, and Allied Trades Skills* or related domains at Level 2.

Domestic household mould cleaning agents should only be applied to areas of mould that do not exceed the size of a two-dollar coin. If the mould spots exceed this size, or they are speckled over a wide surface area like a ceiling; they should not be treated with domestic cleaning agents and should be removed by a professional cleaning service.

- 4 **Definitions**
Specifications refer to documented instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include the following: job specifications from a supervisor or project specific drawings or requirements.
Workplace practice refers to the documented procedures specific to a work site which set out the standard and required practices of that workplace. For this unit standard, *workplace* includes residential dwellings.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to clean a residential dwelling.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 The location of the work to be performed is identified from job specifications.
- 1.2 The work to be performed is described in terms of process and techniques to be used.
- 1.3 Tools, equipment, and cleaning agents are identified and selected to match the job requirements.

Outcome 2

Perform basic cleaning in a residential dwelling under supervision.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 The specified work is carried out and finished in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.2 Tools, equipment, and personal protective equipment (PPE) are used in accordance with workplace practice.

Outcome 3

Complete work operations under supervision.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Tools, equipment, and PPE are maintained and securely stored to prevent tampering and theft in accordance with workplace practice.
- 3.2 Site is cleared of all surplus cleaning agents, equipment, tools, and debris in accordance with workplace practice.
