- 4 Definitions

Site safety plan refers to the documented procedures specific to a workplace including personal protective equipment (PPE), toolbox meetings, hazard signage, and the standard and required practices of that workplace.

Specifications refer to documented instructions (oral, written, graphic) and may include the following: job specifications from a supervisor or project specific drawings or requirements.

Workplace practice refers to the documented procedures specific to a work site which set out the standard and required practices of that workplace. For this unit standard, workplace includes residential dwellings.

# Outcomes and performance criteria

#### **Outcome 1**

Prepare to perform basic roofing maintenance for a residential dwelling.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 The location of the work to be performed is identified from job specifications.
- 1.2 The work to be performed is described in terms of process and techniques to be used.
- 1.3 Quantities of materials are calculated from job specifications.
- 1.4 Tools and equipment are identified and selected to match job requirements.

#### Outcome 2

Perform basic roofing maintenance for a residential dwelling under supervision.

## Performance criteria

- 2.1 Access equipment is arranged in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and supervisor's instructions.
- 2.2 The specified work is carried out and finished in accordance with job specifications and manufacturers' instructions.
- 2.3 Tools, equipment, and PPE are used in accordance with the site safety plan and workplace practice.

# **Outcome 3**

Complete work operations under supervision.

## Performance criteria

- 3.1 Tools, equipment, and PPE are maintained and securely stored to prevent tampering and theft in accordance with the site safety plan and workplace practice.
- 3.2 Site is cleared of all surplus components, equipment, tools, and debris in accordance with the site safety plan and workplace practice.
