Catch, pick up, and carry poultry.

### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Catch and restrain poultry in a manner that minimises risk of injury.
- 1.2 Pick up poultry in a manner that minimises risk of injury.
- 1.3 Lift and carry poultry.

#### Outcome 2

Hold poultry, and present for husbandry procedures.

## Performance criteria

- 2.1 Hold poultry in a manner that avoids undue discomfort or risk of injury.
- 2.2 Hold and present poultry for husbandry procedures.

Range evidence of at least two husbandry procedures is required.

### **Outcome 3**

Place poultry into and remove from containers and/or housing systems.

## Performance criteria

- 3.1 Place poultry into, and remove from, containers and/or housing systems.
- 3.2 Check and maintain poultry density in containers and/or housing systems consistent with welfare codes.
