1.4 Seasonal variations are described in terms of species processed and site locations.

Range species include but are not limited to – bobby calves, sheep and lambs, deer, goat, and other animals used in the fellmongery processing sector.

1.5 The industry is described in terms of its economic importance to New Zealand.

## Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of the regulatory responsibilities, regulatory bodies, and agencies in the New Zealand fellmongery industry.

### Performance criteria

2.1 Regulatory responsibilities are outlined in terms of product quality, meeting customer requirements, and market access.

2.2 Regulatory bodies and agencies are described in terms of their relationship to the fellmongery industry.

Range regulatory bodies and agencies include but are not limited to – the Ministry for Primary Industries, the Meat Industry Association, the New Zealand Leather and Shoe Research Association, Beef and Lamb New Zealand.
