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### Guidance Information

- 1 Definition  
The term *airport* refers to aerodrome as per Civil Aviation Rules.
- 2 Reference to *enterprise procedures* means that all activities must comply with the requirements contained in the current airport exposition, current airport company manuals and procedures, and any relevant legislative and/or regulatory requirements, which may include but are not limited to: Civil Aviation Act 1990, relevant Civil Aviation Rules, New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) Policy.

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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Prepare for friction testing operation of airport runways.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Friction test type is determined in accordance with enterprise procedures.
- 1.2 Approved contractor is arranged in accordance with enterprise procedures.
- 1.3 Equipment provided is checked in accordance with enterprise procedures.

#### Outcome 2

Monitor conduct of friction testing operation of airport runways.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Calibration of equipment is monitored in accordance with enterprise procedures.

- 2.2 Establishment of baseline values is checked in accordance with enterprise procedures.
- 2.3 Friction testing operation is monitored in accordance with enterprise procedures.

### Outcome 3

Record and process friction testing operation information.

### Performance criteria

- 3.1 Friction testing operation information is recorded and processed in accordance with enterprise procedures.
