Guidance Information

1 Definitions

Aeronautical Information Publication New Zealand (AIPNZ) is a regularly published record of information related to air navigation in New Zealand. It has occasional supplements.

NOTAM is a Notice to Airmen. It is a notice distributed by means of telecommunication containing information concerning the establishment, condition, or change in any aeronautical facility, service, procedure, or hazard, the timely knowledge of which is essential to personnel concerned with flight operations. The term *airport* refers to aerodrome as per Civil Aviation Rules. *Works* refers to construction and maintenance work at an airport.

2 Reference to *enterprise procedures* means that all activities must comply with the requirements contained in the current airport exposition, current airport company manuals and procedures, and any relevant legislative and/or regulatory requirements, which may include but are not limited to: Civil Aviation Act 1990, relevant Civil Aviation Rules, New Zealand Defence Force (NZDF) Policy.

Determine information for promulgation.
