Range materials – plastics, metals; coatings – paint, factory steel colour

coating, plain.

1.3 Explain rainwater handling component checks in terms of job specifications.

#### Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of roof surface water discharge factors.

### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Describe roof surface water discharge options in terms of storm water drainage, water harvesting, gutter size, down pipe size, outfalls, rain water head.
- 2.2 Describe roof surface water discharge factors in terms of safeguarding people from injury and property from damage.
- 2.3 Explain the purpose of New Zealand Building Code Acceptable Solution E1 AS1 Surface Water, in terms of its use as a surface water discharge information source.

2.4 Describe storm water discharge and water harvesting in terms of potable water and legionaries disease.
