 - Range where there is no link to eave or ridge, where rafters don't come down to the eave.
- 1.2 Explain installation of valley trays.
 - Range stop ends, joins, sealant, laps, junctions, fixing, tags.
- 1.3 Describe installation of underlay and battens.
- 1.4 Describe the processes for laying and fastening full tiles.
- 1.5 Describe the processes to measure, cut, bend and fit part tiles.
- 1.6 Describe the installation and fixing of flashings and accessories.
- 1.7 Describe sweep and touch-up requirements.

Outcome 2

Demonstrate knowledge of vermin proofing for metal roof tiles.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify and describe potential areas of vermin intrusion.
- 2.2 Describe methods of preventing vermin intrusion.
