### Guidance Information

#### 1 Assessment information

This unit standard may be assessed against on-job or off-job.

Job specifications, equipment used, and job output must conform to current commercial industry practice.

All activities and performance criteria must be carried out in accordance with worksite policies and procedures.

#### 2 Range

Competence may be demonstrated fitting drawers made of either solid wood or manufactured board. For the purpose of this unit standard, manufactured runners must be used.

#### 3 Personal protective equipment, appropriate to job requirements, must be selected and used in accordance with worksite policies and procedures and manufacturer's instructions.

#### 4 Definitions

*Manufactured runners* are runners that are made of metal. They have friction bearing mounted nylon rollers and/or ball bearing slide systems.

*Manufacturer's instructions* are instructions provided by manufacturers of substances, equipment, and machinery used in furniture making. These instructions may include details on safe and correct handling, use and storage of substances and/or details on substance properties. Examples are labels on substance containers, product data sheets, and operator's manuals.

*Worksite policies and procedures* refer to documented policies and to documented or other directions provided to staff. These may include, but are not limited to, ways of managing health and safety, environmental considerations, quality, and production, and must conform to legislation. Examples include standard operating procedures, company health and safety plans, on-site briefings, and supervisor's instructions.

## Outcomes and performance criteria

### Outcome 1

Prepare to assemble and fit drawers to a carcass using manufactured runners.

#### Performance criteria

1.1 Job specifications are obtained and interpreted.

Range drawer runners.

1.2 Equipment, hardware, and drawer material are selected in accordance with job specifications.

### Outcome 2

Assemble and fit drawers to a carcass using manufactured runners.

#### Performance criteria

2.1 Drawer components are checked for defects in accordance with job specifications.

Range physical defects, dimensional variations.

2.2 Drawers are assembled in accordance with job specifications.

2.3 Drawer runners are attached to the drawer sides and carcass ends in accordance with job specifications.

2.4 Drawers are fitted and adjusted to give an even, parallel clearance in accordance with job specifications.

2.5 Machine and work area are made clean, clear, and safe.
