

Title	Assemble and fit traditional drawers to a cabinet using wooden runners

Purpose	People credited with this unit standard are able to: demonstrate and apply knowledge of preparing to assemble and fit; and assemble and fit, traditional drawers to a cabinet using wooden runners.

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Guidance Information

- 1 Assessment information
This unit standard must be assessed against on-job.
All activities and performance criteria must be carried out in accordance with worksite policies and procedures.
- 2 This unit standard does not cover fitting drawers using manufactured runners. These skills and knowledge are covered in Unit 25556, *Assemble and fit drawers to a cabinet using manufactured runners*.
- 3 Personal protective equipment, appropriate to job requirements, must be selected and used in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- 4 Definitions
Manufacturer's instructions are instructions provided by manufacturers of substances, equipment, and machinery used in furniture making. These instructions may include details on safe and correct handling, use and storage of substances and/or details on substance properties. Examples are labels on substance containers, product data sheets, and operator's manuals.
MSDS refers to Material Safety Data Sheets which are documents containing information on toxic substances used in the worksite. It is a requirement of the Environmental Risk Management Authority that all worksites using toxic substances have an MSDS.
Worksite policies and procedures refer to documented policies and to documented or other directions provided to staff. These may include, but are not limited to, ways of managing health and safety, environmental considerations, quality, and production, and must conform to legislation. Examples include standard operating procedures, company health and safety plans, on-site briefings, and supervisor's instructions.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate and apply knowledge of preparing to assemble and fit traditional drawers to a cabinet using wooden runners.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Job specifications are obtained and interpreted.

Range type of cabinet, number of drawers, size of drawers, drawer runner size.
- 1.2 Equipment is selected in accordance with job specifications and confirmed as being in safe working order in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- 1.3 Drawer components are selected in accordance with job specifications.
- 1.4 Adhesive is selected in accordance with job specifications.
- 1.5 Safety considerations related to the use of selected adhesive are explained in accordance with MSDS.

Outcome 2

Assemble and fit traditional drawers to a cabinet using wooden runners.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Drawer components are checked for defects in accordance with job specifications.

Range physical defects, dimensional variations.
- 2.2 Wooden drawer runners are attached to the carcass ends in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.3 Drawer sides are fitted to draw runners and checked for clearance.
- 2.4 Drawers are assembled in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.5 Drawers are fitted to give an even, parallel clearance in accordance with job specifications.

Range one of – hand planing, sanding.
- 2.6 Drawer stops are fitted in accordance with job specifications.
- 2.7 Machine and work area are made clean, clear, and safe.
