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Guidance Information

- 1 Tikanga and kawa related to the content of the Whakairo subfield refer to specific interpretations and understandings of whakapapa, te reo, symbolism, concepts and representation within a whakairo context. They are distinctive from those within the broader context of Te Ao Māori.
- 2 Glossary
Tikanga ā-iwi – tribal cultural practice;
Tikanga – cultural practice;
Tikanga ā-hapū – sub-tribal cultural practice;
Tuakana – anyone in your generation of the same gender that is older than you
Teina – anyone in your generation of the same gender that is younger than you
Topography – the ground plan, layout, and natural environment of the marae and its facilities in relation to restoration, protection, and enhancement.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Follow marae protocol.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Responsibility is independently assumed for personal conduct to ensure that hapū or iwi mana is maintained according to tikanga ā-hapū or iwi.
- 1.2 Roles are independently adopted when required to ensure manuhiri or tangata whenua needs are met according to tikanga ā-hapū or iwi.

Outcome 2

Practice marae protocol.

Performance criteria

2.1 Marae topography is recalled to ensure roles and/or responsibilities concur with tikanga ā-hapū or iwi.

Range marae, wharenuī, wharekai, wharepaku,

2.2 Hierarchical order is maintained by accommodating elder's requests and/or advice without question.

Range kaumātua, rangatahi, tuakana, teina.

2.3 Conduct of teina is censured to ensure tangata whenua or manuhiri are not inconvenienced.

2.4 Co-operation and diplomacy are practiced to ensure mana ā-hapū or iwi is maintained according to tikanga ā-hapū or iwi.
