- Range racing codes – New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, Harness Racing New Zealand, New Zealand Greyhound Racing Association.
- 1.3 The Ministerial portfolio is described in terms of its relevance to the New Zealand Racing Board.
- 1.4 The key functions of the New Zealand Racing Board are described in terms of the Racing Act 2003.
- 1.5 The statutory responsibilities of the New Zealand Racing Board are described in accordance with the Racing Act 2003.
- 1.6 The New Zealand Racing Board is described in terms of its obligations under the Broadcasting Standards in the Broadcasting Act 1989.
- 1.7 The New Zealand Racing Board is described in terms of totalisator agency betting (TAB) brand compliance and staff obligations under the Code of Professional Conduct.
- 1.8 The interaction of businesses within the New Zealand Racing Board is described.
- Range TAB betting channels, raceday control, on-course control, television outside broadcasting.
