### Guidance Information

#### 1 Definitions

*BCATS environment* refers to any workplace or context where work or activities related to the building, construction and allied trades sector take place, such as school workshops, training establishments, outdoor areas and industry placement workplaces.

*BCATS project* refers to a project undertaken in a BCATS environment under general supervision, using a range of tools, equipment and materials, and involving standard processes.

*BCATS project documentation* refers to information and instructions (oral, written, graphic) that detail the parameters of and planning for a BCATS project. The BCATS project documentation may include such things as project briefs, project plans, working drawings, specifications, and quality control procedures.

*Working drawings* are the set of drawings associated with a construction project, and can include plans, elevations, sections, details, or any other drawings that give information about the project.

*Workplace practice* refers to the procedures specific to a BCATS environment, which cover the standard and required practices of that environment.

2 Assessment against this unit standard may occur in any BCATS environment.

3 For the purpose of assessment against this unit standard, the project undertaken must be a cupboard with a drawer.

4 Information supporting assessment decisions should, wherever possible, be collected naturally as the BCATS project progresses.

## **Outcomes and performance criteria**

### **Outcome 1**

Prepare a cutting list for a cupboard with a drawer as a BCATS project.

#### **Performance criteria**

- 1.1 Cupboard and drawer components are identified from BCATS project documentation.
- 1.2 Cutting list is prepared in accordance with BCATS project documentation.

### **Outcome 2**

Mark out, cut, and machine materials for a cupboard with a drawer as a BCATS project.

#### **Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Cupboard and drawer components are marked out and cut to size in accordance with BCATS project documentation.
- 2.2 The surface finish of components is of the standard specified in BCATS project documentation.

### **Outcome 3**

Assemble and finish a cupboard with a drawer as a BCATS project.

#### **Performance criteria**

- 3.1 Cupboard and drawer components are assembled and fitted in accordance with working drawings and job specifications.
- 3.2 Cupboard is finished in accordance with working drawings and job specifications.

### **Outcome 4**

Complete work operations.

#### **Performance criteria**

- 4.1 All operations are safely completed in accordance with workplace practice.
- 4.2 Workplace, tools, plant and equipment are cleaned, and tools, plant and equipment are stored in accordance with workplace practice.
