- 2 Definitions

Seafood product includes any species of – fish, echinoderm, crustacean, or shellfish

Workplace procedures refer to the policies and procedures set out in a verbal or written form by the employer or organisation. Procedures must reflect current legislative requirements.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of the requirements and procedures for packing seafood product.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe the packing requirements for seafood product.

Range	requirements include but are not limited to – product specifications, time and temperature controls, contamination control.
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1.2 Describe the packing procedures for seafood product.

Range procedures may include but are not limited to – product checks prior to packing, packaging type, packing process, labelling, documentation;
evidence of three packing procedures is required.

1.3 Describe the consequences of incorrectly packing seafood product.

Range evidence of three consequences is required.

Outcome 2

Pack seafood product.

Performance criteria

2.1 Pack seafood product.

Range may include but is not limited to – product checks prior to packing, packaging type, packing process, closure, labelling, documentation;
evidence is required for at least three.
