Identify company liability and costs associated with damaged baggage.

Performance criteria

2.1 Legal liability and costs to company are identified.

Range may include but is not limited to – limited release waivers, international liability limits, costs of damaged baggage claims.

Outcome 3

Describe the process for identifying and reporting damaged baggage.

Performance criteria

3.1 Process for identifying and reporting damaged baggage is described.

Range may include but is not limited to – documentation, follow-up, finalisation.
