Range studs, sleepers; studs for hard and soft and heavy conditions.
- 1.2 Describe shoes in terms of preparation for the screw-in stud and treatment of space without stud.
- 1.3 Clear prepared holes, and insert stud to ensure efficient action and functioning when in use without causing damage to horse.
- 1.4 Remove studs and store in a manner which avoids deterioration.
