Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Perform secondary processing for masonry product manufacture.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Requirements for secondary processing are described for specified masonry products in accordance with workplace practice, production schedule, and end use of product.

Range veneers, retaining walls, paving, hollow core masonry.

- 1.2 Secondary processing is performed in accordance with NZS 3109, job specifications, and workplace practice.

Range three of – cutting, splitting, rumbering, bolstering, honing.

Outcome 2

Complete work operations.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 All operations are safely completed, workplace and equipment are cleaned in accordance with workplace practice and environmental safety requirements, and routine maintenance is carried out in accordance with workplace practice.
