Animal tissue includes – primary adherent animal tissue culture, or adherent immortalised tissue culture.
- 5 Glossary
Laboratory procedures refer to documented systems or processes of operation which may be found in a SOP manual, quality management system, or in protocol system documentation. These procedures are external and/or internal laboratory requirements governing laboratory work.
- 6 Recommended for entry: Unit 8035, *Carry out visualisation and measurement of microorganisms*; Unit 8040, *Perform aseptic laboratory techniques*; and Unit 26117, *Work safely in a science laboratory*.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare medium and seed with animal tissue.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Preparation of medium is carried out and sterility of medium confirmed in accordance with laboratory procedures.
- 1.2 Animal tissue is prepared and seeded on medium in accordance with laboratory procedures.

Outcome 2

Incubate and maintain cultures.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Inoculated medium is incubated in accordance with laboratory procedures.
- 2.2 Animal cells are grown in accordance with laboratory procedures.
