- 2 Definition
Biosecurity plan specifies the procedures put in place to prevent the introduction of disease to the pig farm or spread of disease within the pig farm.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Implement a biosecurity plan on a pig farm.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Implement biosecurity procedures for entry and exit of staff and visitors to and from the farm.
- 1.2 Implement biosecurity procedures for cleaning and disinfecting entry areas, work areas, and equipment on the farm.

1.3 Implement biosecurity procedures for animals.

Range incoming pigs, on farm pigs, personnel, rodents, birds, pets or domestic or feral animals;
evidence is required for at least three.

1.4 Implement biosecurity procedures for incoming and outgoing products and equipment to and from the farm.

Outcome 2

Monitor and implement changes to a biosecurity plan, and communicate standard operating procedures in the event of a biosecurity breach.

Performance criteria

2.1 Monitor a biosecurity plan to identify any breaches of biosecurity.

2.2 Implement changes to the biosecurity plan in accordance with the results of monitoring.

2.3 Communicate standard operating procedures in the event of a biosecurity breach.
