Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Demonstrate knowledge of a seafood operation's inventory control system.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe the purpose of a seafood operation's inventory control system.

1.2 Describe the operator's role in a seafood operation's inventory control system in terms of the tasks required to be completed.

Range tasks may include but are not limited to – moving seafood goods to storage, traceability of seafood goods, location plan, data entry, seafood goods reconciliation; evidence is required for three tasks.

1.3 Describe how inventory records are completed by the operator.

1.4 Describe the consequences of errors in relation to the impact on the inventory control system.

Range errors may include but are not limited to – incorrect storage practices, incorrect location delivery, inaccurate record completion; evidence is required for the consequences for two errors.

Outcome 2

Complete inventory records for a seafood operation.

2.1 Complete inventory records for seafood products in a seafood operation.
