Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare hole and fill.

Range hole prepared manually or mechanically using hand-held equipment.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Prepare the hole with shape and size suitable for plant's root system.
- 1.2 Work soil on edges of hole and soil for fill to friable condition with sides of the hole not glazed.

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1.3 Apply soil amendments.

Range may include but is not limited to – sand, peat, water retentive

polymers, fertiliser.

Outcome 2

Prepare plant for planting and plant manually in final site.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Inspect plant before planting for suitability of purpose.
- 2.2 Place root to allow natural growth pattern.
- 2.3 Maintain root to soil contact with friable soil to avoid roots drying out.
- 2.4 Check and report root and soil moisture to ensure sufficient moisture is available within the rootzone to meet plant requirements.
