- 2 Assessment

This standard recognises the ability to work to construction workplace standards under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner whose role is to ensure the completed construction meets industry and regulatory requirements.

Evidence for this unit standard must reflect commercial standards; the verbal and written information covering company policy, standard operating procedures and processes and job-specific instructions.

This unit standard must be assessed under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner in workplace conditions that reflect:

- commercial standards, current health, safety, industry, and workplace requirements; and
- industry requirements for commercially acceptable timeframes.

- 3 Definition

Workplace requirements refer to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which set out the standard and the required practices of that workplace. This may include job specifications, procedures, practices, manufacturer recommendations, technical data sheets and material safety data sheets.

- 4 Range

Evidence of two joinery items is required.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify joinery defects and measure replacement materials.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Joinery items are inspected, and defective parts are identified and documented in accordance with workplace requirements.
- 1.2 Replacement materials are selected and measured in accordance with the job specifications.

Outcome 2

Remedy defects in joinery items.

Range aesthetic, functional, structural, and water tightness.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Defects are cut away and new materials are machined to match the existing profiles.
- 2.2 The replacement components are fixed and matched to existing profiles.
- 2.3 Joinery items are trimmed and finished to meet the job specification.

Outcome 3

Clean and store tools, plant, and equipment used to remedy joinery defects.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Tools, plant, and equipment used to remedy joinery defects are cleaned and stored in accordance with workplace requirements.
- 3.2 Work area is cleared and cleaned in accordance with workplace requirements.
