- 2 Assessment
 

Evidence for this unit standard must reflect commercial competence; the ability to demonstrate knowledge and skills in the context of the currently accepted requirements of a business operating in a commercial environment.

Evidence must also reflect commercial standards; the verbal and written information covering company policy, standard operating procedures and processes and job-specific instructions.

This unit standard must be assessed under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner in workplace conditions that reflect:

- commercial standards, current health, safety, industry, and workplace requirements; and
- industry requirements for commercially acceptable timeframes.

- 3 Definitions

*Cabinetry items* refer to a complete cabinetry job (job, project, or task) consisting of more than three individual cabinets of timber or pre-finished material with cupboard doors or drawers, or a single cabinetry bench top from high-pressure laminate (HPL), clashed flat pressings or timber.

*Workplace requirements* refer to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which set out the standard and the required practices of that workplace. This may include job specifications, procedures, practices, manufacturer recommendations, technical data sheets and material safety data sheets.

**4 Range**

Four different cabinetry items – HPL, clashed flat pressings, timber tops, timber and pre-finished cupboard doors, and drawers, timber and pre-finished cabinetry.

**Outcomes and performance criteria****Outcome 1**

Prepare to manufacture cabinetry.

**Performance criteria**

- 1.1 The work area is prepared.
- 1.2 Working drawings are used to identify materials required for the cabinetry work.
- 1.3 Materials required to complete the work are calculated and ordered.
- 1.4 Personal protective equipment is selected and prepared.

**Outcome 2**

Manufacture cabinetry.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Cabinetry materials are machined to meet the job specification.
- 2.2 Adhesive is applied to required surfaces.
- 2.3 Trimming, edging, finishing, and protection of cabinetry is completed to meet the job specification.

**Outcome 3**

Assemble cabinetry.

**Performance criteria**

- 3.1 Working drawings are used to identify the required fixing methods.
- 3.2 Fixings are ordered to meet the job specifications.
- 3.3 Onsite or offsite assembly is determined.
- 3.4 Cabinetry is assembled, and the joints are fixed to meet the job specification.
- 3.5 The components are assembled to meet the job specification.
- 3.6 The doors and drawers and attachments are fitted to the cabinetry.

- 3.7 Finishing procedures are completed.
- 3.8 Post-operational procedures are completed in accordance with workplace requirements.
