- 2 Assessment
Evidence for this unit standard must reflect commercial competence; the ability to demonstrate knowledge and skills in the context of the currently accepted requirements of a business operating in a commercial environment.

Evidence must also reflect commercial standards; the verbal and written information covering company policy, standard operating procedures and processes and job-specific instructions.

This unit standard must be assessed under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner in workplace conditions that reflect:

- commercial standards, current health, safety, industry, and workplace requirements; and
- industry requirements for commercially acceptable timeframes.

- 3 Definition
Workplace requirements refer to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which set out the standard and the required practices of that workplace. This may include job specifications, procedures, practices, manufacturer recommendations, technical data sheets and material safety data sheets.

- 4 Range
Three installations from shop fixtures and fittings, kitchen cabinetry, laundry and wardrobe cabinetry, timber, and sheet panelling.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Prepare to install cabinetry.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Cabinetry fittings and fixtures required for the cabinetry installation are obtained in accordance with the job specifications.
- 1.2 The work area for cabinetry installation is checked in terms of correct measurements, levels, and access.
- 1.3 Service and on-site requirements relevant to fitting the assembled components are identified and addressed.
- 1.4 Personal protective equipment is selected and prepared.

Outcome 2

Install cabinetry.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Cabinetry fittings and fixtures are set out according to the working drawings.
- 2.2 Cabinetry components are assembled and installed according to the job specification.
- 2.3 Cabinetry trimming, finishing and protection is completed.
- 2.4 Specialist work requirements are identified, communicated, and recorded.
- 2.5 Post-operational procedures are completed in accordance with workplace requirements.
