This unit standard must be assessed under the supervision of a commercially competent practitioner in workplace conditions that reflect:

- commercial standards, current health, safety, industry, and workplace requirements; and
- industry requirements for commercially acceptable timeframes.

3 Definition

Workplace requirements refer to the documented procedures specific to a workplace which set out the standard and the required practices of that workplace. This may include job specifications, procedures, practices, manufacturer recommendations, technical data sheets and material safety data sheets.

4 Range

Two different work tasks.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Work in a team to complete joinery tasks.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Role and responsibilities as a team member are confirmed in terms of task requirements and the job specifications.
- 1.2 Team member attributes are demonstrated throughout the work task.

- 1.3 Team member communication requirements are demonstrated, ensuring the work task is completed on time and meets the job specifications.
- 1.4 Legislation, standards, and guidelines are followed by the team member for the successful completion of the work task.
- 1.5 Procedures when asking for assistance from other team members are followed in terms of company requirements.
- 1.6 Work procedures are followed in accordance with team member role and responsibilities.
- 1.7 Procedures for giving and receiving feedback are followed in terms of workplace requirements.
- 1.8 Work task documentation, recording and reporting procedures are followed in terms of own role and responsibilities.
