3 Definitions

Boning – a retained or restricted carcass that is boned under supervision of an official assessor to verify separation from non-retained product.

Official assessor is an ante-mortem and post-mortem examiner appointed under Section 79 of the Animal Products Act 1999 to carry out animal material and animal product examinations.

Organisational requirements – instructions to staff on policies and procedures that are documented in memo, electronic, or manual format and available in the workplace.

Apply control boning parameters to detained product in a meat processing operation.
