- 3 Definitions
Company requirements refers to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are available in the workplace. These requirements may include – company policies and procedures, work instructions, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.
Industry guidelines refers to those practices and procedures commonly used as standard procedures to produce items of acceptable merchantable quality in the industrial textile fabrication industry such as related textbook descriptors.
Manufacturer's information refers to technical information for a machine or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.
Suitable tools and equipment refer to industry approved tools and equipment that are recognised within the industry as being the most suited to complete the task in a professional and competent manner with due regard to safe working practices.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Determine staffing to meet industrial textile fabrication job requirements.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Staffing requirements are reviewed and determined.
- 1.2 Staffing requirements are determined in terms of overall job duration.
- 1.3 Staffing requirements are determined in terms of skill and experience needed.
- 1.4 Staffing requirements are documented.

Outcome 2

Determine workspace and equipment to meet industrial textile fabrication job requirements.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Workspace requirements are determined in terms of size and type.
- 2.2 Machine and equipment requirements, and duration are determined.
- 2.3 Workspace, machine and equipment requirements are documented.

Outcome 3

Determine materials to meet industrial textile fabrication job requirements.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Material requirements are determined.
- 3.2 Material requirements are listed on a job sheet in terms of type and specification range suitable for use as a basis for procurement activities.
