- 3 Definitions

Company requirements refers to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are available in the workplace. These requirements may include – company policies and procedures, work instructions, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.

Industry guidelines refers to those practices and procedures commonly used as standard procedures to produce items of acceptable merchantable quality in the industrial textile fabrication industry such as related textbook descriptors.

Manufacturer's information refers to technical information for a machine or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.

Suitable tools and equipment refer to industry approved tools and equipment that are recognised within the industry as being the most suited to complete the task in a professional and competent manner with due regard to safe working practices.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Confirm material requirements for industrial textile fabrication jobs.

Range textiles and other materials.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Material requirements are obtained in terms of type and specification range.
- 1.2 Specified materials are confirmed to be fit for purpose.
- 1.3 Textiles and materials options are determined.

Outcome 2

Determine material availability and price for industrial textile fabrication jobs.

Range textiles and other materials required.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Material alternatives are researched using a variety of methods.
Range may include – email, phone, price lists, product specification information, manufacturer websites, hosting supplier representatives, visiting suppliers.
- 2.2 Material supplier alternatives are evaluated.
Range price, availability and delivery, performance, warranty and support.

Outcome 3

Complete material orders for industrial textile fabrication jobs.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Textiles and materials are ordered.
