- Three data reviews of which one has to be a flow time series of five years with multiple rating curves.
- 4 Definition

Organisational procedures refer to the policies and procedures set out in a verbal or written form by the employer or organisation. Procedures must be consistent with current legislative requirements and manufacturer's recommendations or instructions where relevant.

# Outcomes and performance criteria

# **Outcome 1**

Present statistical summaries and analysis of data, as part of a quality management system.

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#### Performance criteria

1.1 Compile a set of statistical summaries and graphical presentations of hydrometric data.

- 1.2 Analyse information about processes from each station that may help to identify anomalies in the data not previously detected or adequately explained.
- 1.3 Take remedial action to correct anomalies in data.

## Outcome 2

Provide quality assured information for users.

#### Performance criteria

- 2.1 Determine a user's requirements for reporting information.
- 2.2 Describe organisational licensing and data release policies for a user.
- 2.3 Provide the information to a user, in the appropriate form, with all relevant metadata, including explanation of data quality status.
