Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Identify and evaluate opportunities to maintain currency in the hair fashion industry.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Own personal requirements for professional development are identified in terms of maintaining currency in the hair fashion industry.
- 1.2 Opportunities for ensuring currency in the hair fashion industry are identified and described in terms of their role in ongoing professional development.

Range opportunities may include but are not limited to – colour workshops, hairdressing competitions, hair expos, guest artists, company demonstrations, one on one coaching.
- 1.3 Opportunities are evaluated to determine availability, cost, relevance to personal requirements, and timing.

- 1.4 A plan is established to implement opportunities that will ensure currency in the hair fashion industry.

Range plan includes – a minimum of five opportunities over 12 months.
