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### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Handle product hygienically in a primary industry operation.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Follow personal hygiene requirements.
- 1.2 Maintain clothing and equipment.
- 1.3 Follow personal hygiene requirements when moving around the workplace and through entries and exits.

- 1.4 Inspect product and work area for signs of contamination and product safety hazards.
- Range product safety hazards may include but are not limited to – poor personal hygiene, poor storage, poor handling, and poor cleaning practices; evidence of two examples is required.
- 1.5 Handle product hygienically.
- Range may include but is not limited to – clothing, footwear, product handling, product storage, equipment cleaning; evidence is required of two examples.

**Outcome 2**

Monitor product safety in a work area of a primary industry operation.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Maintain work area and equipment in a hygienic state.
- 2.2 Collect and dispose of waste.
- 2.3 Monitor product safety during usage and storage of equipment and supplies.
- 2.4 Monitor critical control points to meet product safety requirements.
- Range monitoring may include but is not limited to – checks, inspections, tests; evidence of two forms of monitoring is required.
- 2.5 Identify and take corrective action and/or report any out-of-control processes or situations.
- 2.6 Record product safety information.
