### Outcomes and performance criteria

#### Outcome 1

Ensure goods and containers are ready for loading in a primary industry operation.

#### Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify and confirm consignments as correctly prepared for loading.
 

Range	preparation includes but is not limited to – consignment documentation, free from damage.

1.2 Complete housekeeping of work areas.

Range housekeeping includes but is not limited to – clean environment, free of rubbish, equipment stored, clear work areas.

1.3 Check containers to ensure they are free from contamination and damage.

Range checking includes but is not limited to – rust, water, foreign matter, odours, pests, container damage.

1.4 Check refrigerated containers to ensure they are at the correct temperature for the goods being transported.

1.5 Advise personnel of duties and equipment for loading.

1.6 Position and fasten ramps to the container to facilitate entry and egress.

## Outcome 2

Load containers with goods ready for dispatch in a primary industry operation.

### Performance criteria

2.1 Load consignment.

Range loading includes but is not limited to – quantity, volumes, weights, packing sequence, dimensions.

2.2 Check loaded goods to ensure that they are secure and free from damage.

2.3 Maintain freight container at correct temperature for consignment being loaded.

2.4 Action records and documentation required for consignment of goods.

2.5 Check loaded containers to ensure that they are sealed, secure, and readied for transportation.

2.6 Load containers.

Range compliance includes but is not limited to – safety procedures, operating procedures, quality procedures.
