Labelling – may include but not limited to MPI seal, product label, boarder control seal.

Manufacturer's specifications – instructions from the manufacturer which outlines the specifications, parts, maintenance, service schedule, repair and running of specific equipment.

Organisational requirements – instructions to staff on policies and procedures which are documented in memo, electronic or manual format and are available in the workplace.

Primary products food processing operation – covers a meat processing, dairy processing, seafood or baking yeasts manufacturing operation.

3 Evidence for the practical components of this unit standard must be supplied from within the workplace.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Set up, weigh, and send products for packing in a primary products food processing operation.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Carry out set up procedure for the weighing equipment in accordance with organisational requirements.
- 1.2 Set and adjust weight controls and check weighing procedure to achieve product specifications in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and organisational requirements.
- 1.3 Weigh products and separate into various weight ranges to meet company and customer specifications.
- 1.4 Dispatch products for packing in accordance with organisational requirements.

Outcome 2

Label containers in a primary products food processing operation.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Prepare containers for each product in accordance with company and customer specifications.
- 2.2 Check product identification procedures to ensure they meet company specifications and customer specifications.
- 2.3 Set up labelling equipment in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and organisational requirements.
- 2.4 Operate labelling equipment in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and organisational requirements.
- 2.5 Position labels on each container to meet organisational and statutory requirements.
- 2.6 Check printed labels to ensure they identify the content of individual containers in accordance with organisational requirements.
