- 2 Definitions

*Grounds maintenance* includes mowing, raking, sweeping, and garden maintenance. *Minor maintenance* includes those carried out on – water supply, stable fixtures, fencing and gates, stable surrounds, minor replacements.

*Routine maintenance* includes clean up after a vet or farrier visit, replacement of equipment and grooming gear into its designated place, cleaning feed storage area, first aid kit maintenance, cleaning horse float.

*Temporary maintenance* includes maintenance made to water supply until permanent repairs can be carried out.

*Workplace procedures* – the procedures and standards set by the client or employing organisation. Workplace procedures should reflect equipment manufacturer's requirements, and current legislation.

- 3 For the purposes of assessment:
  - evidence must be presented in accordance with workplace procedures.
  - assessment for the practical components of this unit standard must be supplied from a commercial horse enterprise or recognised voluntary equine organisation.
  - evidence is required for examples across a range of types of maintenance and repairs which are routinely carried out and/or typical of the equine workplace.
