<b>Purpose</b>	<p>This unit standard is for people who have: passed the New Zealand Transport Agency testing requirements; been issued their Class 1 New Zealand learner driver licence; and wish to have this recognised as prior learning by an education organisation holding consent to assess, and listed on their Record of Achievement.</p> <p>People credited with this unit standard are able to: learn to drive a vehicle within the conditions of a Class 1 New Zealand learner driver licence.</p>

- This standard must only be awarded through a process of recognition of prior learning. This is evidenced through an application for award using a completed application form and presentation of a Class 1 New Zealand driver licence issued by the New Zealand Transport Agency. 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### Outcomes and evidence requirements

#### Outcome 1

Learn to drive a vehicle within the conditions of a Class 1 New Zealand learner driver licence.

#### Evidence requirements

- 1.1 Evidence must only be in the form of an official photographic Class 1 New Zealand driver licence issued after 27 February 2012 by the New Zealand Transport Agency.

Range – either one of a learner, restricted, or full driver licence.
