- 4 Clean down for changeovers may be carried out between organic and conventional runs, between conventional and organic runs, and at end of packing season.

- 1.2 Clean all parts of machinery in the packing line.
- 1.3 Remove all traces of plant product from packing line.
- 1.4 Use approved cleaning agents.

Describe the mode of action of cleaning agents used in the workplace.

**Performance criteria**

- 2.1 Describe the mode of action of cleaning agents in terms of controlling substances or organisms in the workplace.
