- 3 Definitions

Greenhouse work refers to general duties related to care and harvest of a greenhouse crop.

Workplace procedures refer to policies and procedures set down by the employer or host organisation for safety, operation, and effective use of the pipe rail trolley and must be consistent with manufacturer's instructions.
- 4 Pipe rail trolley refers to:
 - Rail bound, battery powered self-driven single or double scissor platforms.
 - Rail bound, battery powered self-driven elevating platforms using means other than scissors for elevating the platform.
 - Manual lift/manual propelled rail bound pipe rail trolleys.
 - Non-rail bound elevating work platforms used in the greenhouse industry for crop care.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Operate a pipe rail trolley for greenhouse work.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Carry out visual checks of the pipe rail trolley before use to ensure it is in good working order and safe to use.

- 1.2 Identify the location of emergency stop control before use.
- 1.3 Identify, and report or remove any potential hazards in the working area before and during use.
- 1.4 Operate the pipe rail trolley in a safe manner.
- 1.5 Shut down and store the pipe rail trolley.
- 1.6 Report any problems with the pipe rail trolley to the supervisor.
