- 1.2 Prick out seedlings or rooted cuttings from trays using techniques that avoid damage to seedlings or rooted cuttings.

- 1.3 Position roots of seedlings or rooted cuttings without distortion or damage to root hairs during transfer.
- 1.4 Firm in seedling or rooted cutting maintaining root and stem orientation.
- 1.5 Apply water immediately after pricking out.
- 1.6 Label seedlings or rooted cuttings.

Outcome 2

Transplant and pot-on young plants into containers, apply water, and label.

Range evidence of four plant species is required.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Prepare and/or select media, and select container type if required, and fill.
- 2.2 Trim root systems to suitable length.
- 2.3 Place and firm plants maintaining root and stem orientation.
- 2.4 Apply water to plants immediately after transplanting.
- 2.5 Label young plants.
