Purpose	People credited with this unit standard will be able to describe the global and national influences, and demonstrate knowledge of optimal performance of, and regional influences, on a specific primary production system.

Definitions

A *global event* could be any significant political, social, environmental, or economic event that has an effect globally on that production system.

A *primary production system* is any system that produces a primary product from a primary industries workplace or environment, e.g., milk solids, wool, sheep meat, pip fruit.

A *specific primary production system* is a production system specific to an industry, e.g., a dairy farm, a kiwifruit orchard, a poultry farm.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Describe the global influences on a specific primary production system.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Describe a production system in terms of the impact of overseas producers and markets.
- 1.2 Describe a production system in terms of the potential impact of international exchange rates.
- 1.3 Describe a production system in terms of the potential impact of global events.

Range evidence of two global events is required;
evidence of a minimum of three outcomes of each global event is required.

Outcome 2

Describe the national influences on a specific primary production system.

Performance criteria

2.1 Describe a production system in terms of the impact of political, social, economic, and environmental influences.

Range evidence of at least one of each influence is required.

2.2 Describe a production system in terms of the structure and function of any affiliated relevant industry organisation(s) or peak bodies.

Outcome 3

Demonstrate knowledge of optimal performance of, and regional influences on, a specific primary production system.

Performance criteria

3.1 Describe a primary production system in terms of the key regional requirements for optimal performance.

Range evidence of at least four key regional requirements is required.

3.2 Compare and describe a specific primary production system in terms of regional or system variations.

Range evidence of at least two regions or systems is required, with one being local.

3.3 Describe a specific primary production system in terms of options that are available to improve the regional performance where regional conditions are not optimal.

Range evidence of at least four options is required.
