Definitions

Compliance regulations and requirements are any protocol or regulation supported by legislation as set out by government and local bodies, such as Environmental Protection Authority (EPA), Department of Conservation (DOC), the Animal Welfare Act 1999, or industry groups and peak bodies, for example Beef and Lamb, Dairy NZ, Agcarm. These requirements reflect industry best practice and are the accepted standards within that industry.

Industry best practice is determined by relevant industry peak bodies, and government agencies and is supported by data and other information from these organisations, for example Dairy NZ and Ministry for Primary Industries.

A *primary production system* is any system that produces a primary product from a primary industries workplace or environment, for example milk solids, wool, meat, fruit.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Describe compliance regulations and their impact on a primary production system.

Range evidence of a minimum of four regulations is required.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Identify compliance regulations in terms of their impact on the production system.
- 1.2 Describe the rationale for the compliance regulations in terms of the production system.
