- 2.2 Select, prepare, use, and monitor equipment for planting.
- 2.3 Maintain plant health before, during and after planting.
- 2.4 Recognise, rectify and/or report plant problems or anomalies.

Outcome 3

Complete post planting operations.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Select and install anchorage or apply support.
- 3.2 Remove waste from the site and dispose, treat or recycle.
- 3.3 Clean and maintain equipment used for planting.
- 3.4 Maintain records.

Outcome 4

Care for newly planted plants.

Range evidence of care for a period of eight weeks is required.

Performance criteria

- 4.1 Select, prepare, operate and maintain equipment used for ongoing plant care.
 - Range plant care includes but is not limited to watering, shoot management, weed control.
- 4.2 Monitor and maintain an optimum environment for plant growth.
- 4.3 Maintain plant care records.
