Prepare specialist nursery machinery for use.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Select machinery suitable for the task.
- 1.2 Check and service the machine according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 1.3 Follow safety guidelines according to manufacturer's instructions.

Outcome 2

Operate specialist nursery machinery.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Wear personal protective equipment suitable for the task.
- 2.2 Operate machinery and complete the task without damage to plants, and other equipment, property structures or people according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.3 Monitor and adjust machinery as required during operation to achieve optimum performance according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.4 Shut down machinery according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.5 Report any machinery problems and anomalies.

Outcome 3

Maintain specialist nursery machinery.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Clean, maintain, and store machinery.
- 3.2 Collect, treat, and dispose of, or recycle, waste generated by the activities and cleaning procedure.
