Workplace procedures refer to verbal or written instructions to staff on procedures for implementing and monitoring crop production activities. Workplace procedures must comply with health and safety legislation and be consistent with the workplace health and safety plan.

Outcome 1

Develop standard operating procedures for a horticulture workplace.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Compare current standard operating procedures with workplace quality control documents.
- 1.2 Write standard operating procedures using a language that is appropriate for the target audience in accordance with workplace procedures.

Range audience may include – staff or contractors.

- 1.3 Write standard operating procedures using a format which is in accordance with workplace procedures.
- 1.4 Review and amend standard operating procedures in response to workplace feedback in accordance with workplace procedures.
