Instruct refers to techniques such as explaining workplace procedures and quality standards, giving verbal instructions, demonstrating techniques, monitoring outcomes and giving feedback.

Nursery crop production schedule refers to a workplace plan for producing a line of plants that is consistent with the needs of the nursery operation and the requirements of the target market.

Workplace procedures – the policies and procedures on safety and operation set down by the employer or organisation.
- 3 All evidence presented in this unit standard must be in accordance with workplace procedures.

Implement nursery crop production schedules.

Monitor nursery crops.

Range evidence of two crops is required.

Performance criteria

2.1 Keep records in accordance with the production schedule.

2.2 Report progress.

2.3 Identify variations from the crop production schedule.

2.4 Respond to variations in accordance with the production schedule.

2.5 Record and report pre-sale or pre-dispatch quality checks.
