*Workplace plan* refers to a document detailing steps for an aspect of the production or processing of horticultural produce. It must be consistent with the regulatory requirements and quality standards of the target market and with health and safety legislation.

*Workplace procedures* refer to policies and procedures on safety, operation, and production set down by the employer or host organisation.
