- 3 Definitions

Equipment is property that is used in business operations. Examples of post-harvest equipment include devices, machines, refrigeration plant, testing equipment and tools.

Out-of-specification performance is performance of the equipment that does not meet workplace requirements or manufacturer's instructions.

Workplace procedures refer to verbal or written instructions to staff on procedures for the worksite and equipment. Workplace procedures should reflect best practice as reflected by manufacturer's instructions, comply with health and safety legislation and be consistent with the workplace health and safety plan.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Supervise the operation of post-harvest equipment.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Supervise equipment operation.
- 1.2 Coordinate equipment cleaning, repair and maintenance.
- 1.3 Keep records on post-harvest equipment.

Outcome 2

Monitor post-harvest equipment during post-harvest operations.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify out-of-specification performance.
- 2.2 Respond to out-of-specification performance.
- 2.3 Complete reports on adjustments made to post-harvest equipment.
