Outcome 2

Identify seasonal operational requirements of plant, machinery and/or equipment, and plan for their availability.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Identify appropriate plant, machinery and/or equipment required to meet seasonal operational requirements.
- 2.2 Plan for their readiness and availability to meet seasonal operational requirements.

Outcome 3

Develop and manage a routine maintenance schedule or cleaning procedure for plant, machinery and/or equipment.

Performance criteria

- 3.1 Develop either a maintenance schedule or cleaning procedure for plant, machinery and/or equipment in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.
- 3.2 Manage the implementation of maintenance schedule or cleaning procedure.

Outcome 4

Plan and manage the implementation of training requirements for the use of plant, machinery and/or equipment.

Performance criteria

- 4.1 Plan a training programme for the safe use of plant, machinery and/or equipment.
- 4.2 Manage the implementation of the training programme.
